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Tryouts

FLG's tryouts are designed to select the best talent. The drills used in the tryouts are from the FLG Lacrosse Curriculum and are intended to test the player's ability to make decisions in different aspects of the game. Our highly knowledgeable evaluators assist in the selection process.

Organizational Meetings

Organizational meetings are a chance for parents and players to get together and meet their coaches for the first time after being selected to play for FLG. A one-hour PowerPoint presentation by the FLG staff explains the program's philosophies, events, practices, tournaments and vital topics.

Recruiting Seminar

Our recruiting seminar assists FLG Select players and their parents by providing helpful information on the college recruiting process. FLG alumni who have gone on to Division I, II, III and MCLA schools, are on-hand to discuss their own recruiting experiences and offer advice. During the seminar, parents and players are free to ask questions about the recruiting process, lacrosse, school, life and much more.



Positional Clinics

At the FLG Positional Clinics, it's all about progression. This six week clinic series explores the nuances of five different positions (face-offs or draws, goaltending, close and long stick defense, midfield and attack). Each week, we build on skills taught the session prior to ensure a solid foundation of understanding and development.

Box League/Clinics

The FLG box lacrosse training allows players to expand their

knowledge of the game by exposing them to all styles of play. Over an eight-week period, players from 3rd through 12th grade will have an opportunity to work on a variety of abilities, such as picking, screening, cutting and scoring off rebounds, skills they may not normally focus on. The first four to five weeks are run like a clinic with drills, handson coaching and game play. The box tournament takes place during the final three to four weeks, concluding with Championships and an All Star Game on the last day.

Youth Winter Clinics

The FLG Winter Youth Clinics are all about development. We create a fun and interactive atmosphere for boys and girls ranging from kindergarten to 5th grade to start developing their hand-eye coordination, movement and space awareness skills. At the clinics, young athletes learn the basics of the game and familiarize themselves with lacrosse concepts through creative, traditional, and age-appropriate drills.

FLG Select and Non-FLG Select players are welcomed to sign up and train with some of the best coaches in lacrosse.



FLG Lacrosse was founded on the goal to get boys and girls across Long Island to fall in love with the sport. At FLG Camp, a one-week summer day program, campers experience a fun, creative opportunity to work

on fundamentals and skills in an encouraging and positive atmosphere. The camp is split into teams with campers competing throughout the week to earn points for their team. At the end of each day, our counselors recap the team's performance and announce the FLG Lacrosse Camper of the Day.
