December 21st	Attend FLG Recruiting Night at HQ. This night includes and FLG Alumni panel, question & answer session, and meet & greet.
Month of January	Visit Colleges & attend Prospect Days at College Campuses.
January 22nd	Women's Recruiting Webinar - 3 College Coaches on call, question and answer included. Up to 90 minutes.
January 29th	Men's Recruiting Webinar - 3 College Coaches on call, question and answer included. Up to 90 minutes.
February School Break	Great time to visit College Campuses.
March to April during Spring Season	Throughout your Spring season, stay in touch with schools that have been recruiting you. Keep them updated on your season.
March 14th	Start Emailing Schools that are out of the College Playoffs through lacrosse recruits. *Make sure your High School and club team schedule is updated on your Lacrosse Recruits profile.
End of May	Start to purchase film packages from Spring JV or Varsity games and for the various summer events you will be attending.
June 1st	Email all colleges through Lacrosse Recruits and let them know where you will be over the summer.
June & July	Email School's weekly and maintain contact with various college programs.
